Dr. Reichman is Professor Emeritus of History at California State University, East Bay and author of *Understanding Academic Freedom* (2021), an introduction to the topic, and the prize-winning *The Future of Academic Freedom* (2019), a collection of essays. He is former vice-president of the American Association of University Professors (AAUP) and Chair of the AAUP Foundation. From 2012 to 2021 he served as Chair of AAUP's Committee on Academic Freedom and Tenure.

Dr. Abad is an Assistant Professor of Communications in Nevada State University's Department of Data, Media, and Design. They've been featured on podcasts like The Art People Podcast, Seeing Color Podcast, City Cast and Latinos Who Lunch. In the fall of 2022, they curated an art show titled "Two Cultures, One Family," for Marjorie Barrick at the University of Nevada Las Vegas.
